4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: If exposed to chlorine or other vapours, remove to fresh air. Obtain medical attention.

Skin Contact: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash thoroughly with plenty of running water. Obtain medical attention if symptoms develop.

Eye Contact: Keeping eye open, immediately irrigate with water or eyewash for 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention immediately.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting.
Provided the patient is conscious, wash out mouth with water and give water to drink. Obtain medical attention immediately.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES
